FOR INDUSTRIAL VISITS

Objectives:

- 1. To integrate subject knowledge with real-life experience.
- 2. To give a practical exposure to classroom teaching.
- 3. To build up and strengthen the Industry Academia collaboration.

Procedure:

1. Permission from the visiting organization. Classes shall be allowed for Industrial Visits, in the following pattern:

- 2. Permission from Principal with details of the trip cost and funds collected.
- 3. Make necessary arrangements for travel and visit. Also, collect parent's declaration (in case of out station visit)
- 4. Formal attire and discipline to be maintained during the visit.
- 5. After the visit, submit the Industrial visit form duly filled, along with two photographs online to the Industrial Visits co-ordinator.
- 6. The organizing staff should maintain a report drafted by the student, covering the following areas; History, Business, Departments (such as Marketing, HR, Finance and Accounts) and the future plans of the organization.
