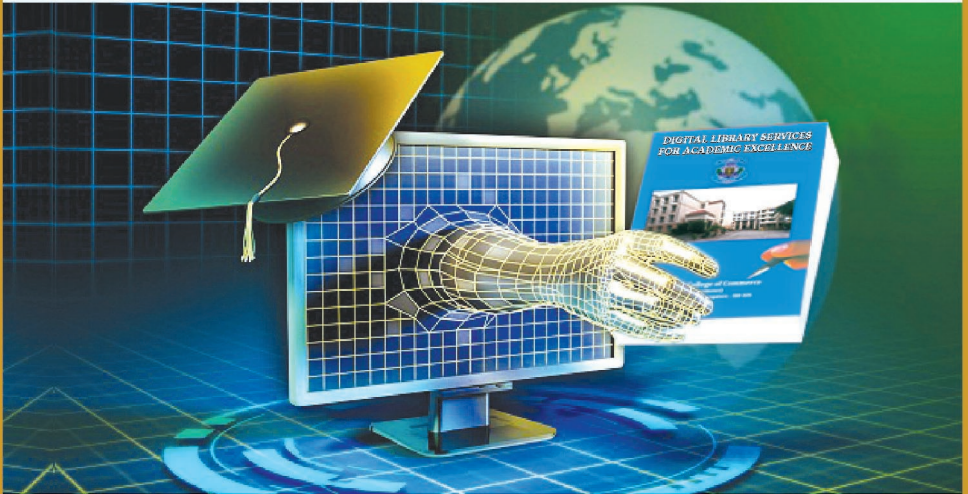

About Conference

New developments in the field of ICT have impacted the scope and the potential of digital library services with far-reaching consequences for education and social transformation. Digital Libraries (DLs) are emerging as an important area of teaching and research for the LIS community. Most of the scholarly literature publishers including Commercial, Societal and individual have provided access to their contents either from their own search and access platforms or aggregators services. While the movement of Open Access publication has emerged as a big boon for the academic community, it has also thrown many challenges like predatory journals resulting in shortcuts and low quality research publications. Indian LIS professionals have taken the lead for setting up of digital archives in the form of Institutional repositories. A number of open source softwares are available both for Library Automation and setting up of digital libraries. Developments in Electronic Resource Management systems, especially the Web scale Discover Tools have shown new ways for LIS.

A number of conferences, seminars and workshops are being organized all over the country to familiarize and train different stakeholders in information delivery services including issues like digital rights management. Public, academic, and special librarians need to develop advanced skills to handle complex online databases and get themselves acquainted with various discovery tools and issues related to Intellectual Property Rights. There is a need for developing required soft skills especially in the digital environment.

In view of this the Department of Library and Information Center is organizing a One day State Level Conference on “**Digital Library Services for Academic Excellence: Opportunities and Challenges**” aimed to debate various developments and issues on the subject.

About the College
