# St. Joseph's College of Commerce (Autonomous)

St. Joseph's College of Commerce (SJCC) formerly a part of St. Joseph's College, established in the year 1882, is managed by the Bangalore Jesuit Educational Society (BJES). The Commerce Department was established in the year 1949 and it became an independent college with its own building in Brigade Road in the year 1972. The college has in its Vision a model for higher education which encourages individuals to dream of a socially just world and in its Mission a strategy to empower individuals in realizing that dream. With an objective of imparting quality education in the field of Commerce and Management, the college has been innovating in all aspects of higher education over a long period of time. These innovations were further bolstered with the granting of autonomous status to the college by UGC in September 2005. From then on, the college has taken a lead in reforming curriculum and syllabus, examination and evaluation pattern, and teaching and learning methods through the Board of Studies, the Academic Council and the Governing Council composed of eminent academicians, industry representatives and notable alumni.

The college has undergone four cycles of NAAC accreditation starting from the year 2000 in which it secured 'five stars', next in the year 2007 an 'A' grade, in the year 2012 again an 'A' grade and recently in February 2021 an 'A++'. It is one of the very few institutions in the country to have secured A++ grade in the fourth cycle under the Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF) and the first college in Karnataka to do so. The college was declared as a 'College with Potential for Excellence' in the year 2010. In 2011, SJCC was recognized as a Research Centre by Bangalore University. The college has consistently been ranked among the top 100 colleges in the country by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), Ministry of Education, Government of India, since its inception in 2017.

memories that outlive the fest itself.

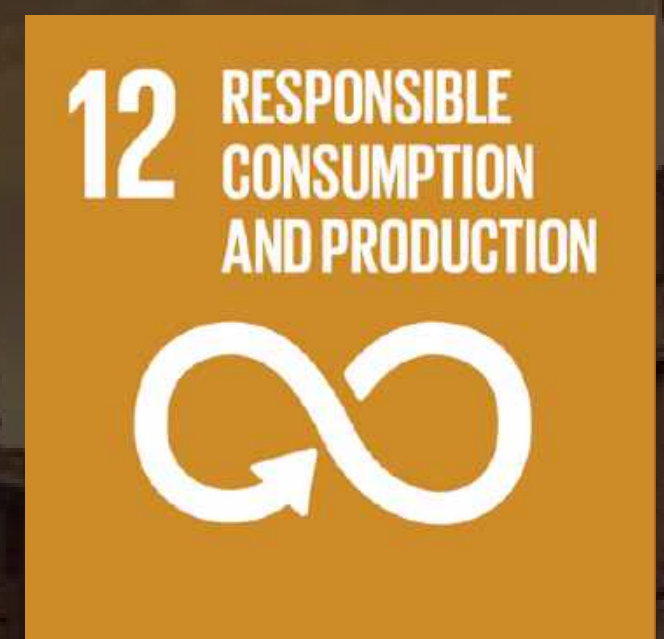
Dhwani 2026 is where skill earns recognition, creativity commands

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## GENERAL

- Dhwani 2026 will be held in SJCC's campus.
- The wristbands should be worn throughout the fest.
- The judges' decision will be considered final for all the events.

## FOR PARTICIPANTS:

- All participants must carry a valid College ID card and present it upon request.
- Participants are required to report to the respective event venue at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
- Participants registering for multiple events must ensure that the event timings do not overlap. The organizing committee will not be responsible for schedule clashes.
- In the event that an activity reaches its maximum participant capacity, the organizing committee reserves the right to close registrations at any time.
- Participants must accept and abide by any event cancellations or changes made at the discretion of the organizing committee.
- Online registrations will close at 4:00 PM on 20th January, 2026.
- Parking facilities are not available inside the campus.
- Any form of vulgar behavior, indiscipline, or malpractice will result in immediate disqualification.
- Participants are advised not to carry hazardous, valuable, or fragile items, as the organizers will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- The events Battle of Bands and Street Dance Battle are open to all.



# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## FOR CONTINGENT COLLEGES

- Colleges must register as contingent to be eligible for the Overall Trophy.
- The contingent registration fee is ₹15,000 which includes registration for 15 cheer squad members.
- To qualify for the 'Overalls', colleges must participate in a minimum of six '5 star events'
- Alterations to the contingent participants list will not be allowed after registration closes.
- Each college can send only one team or individual per event under the contingent registration.
- Registration for events such as Battle of Bands and Dance Battle is separate and is not covered under the contingent registration fee.
- Each college must designate two contingent leaders.



# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## FOR NON-CONTINGENT COLLEGES

- Non-contingent participants can participate in all events.
- Non-contingents will not be considered for overalls.
- On-spot registrations for non-contingent participants is permitted, registration for the same will close one hour before the event starts.

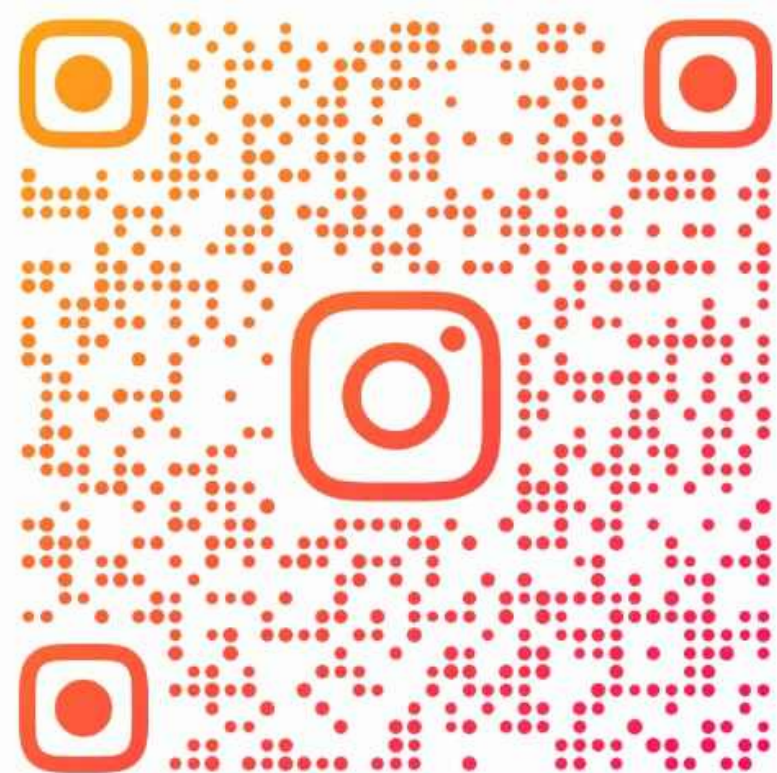
