National Education Policy 2020 - A Socio-cultural Perspective

On the 21st August, 2020 a webinar on the topic "National Education Policy 2020 – A socio-cultural perspective" was organized. The resource person for the webinar was Prof. Sukhadeo Thorat, an eminent academician, former chairmanof UGC and ICCSR and a Padmashree awardee. The event was attended by about 500 participants who included academicians, researchers, teachers, students and the general public from all over the country.

Prof. Thorat touched upon the socio-cultural aspects of the education policy pertaining to the higher education sector in India. He evaluated the policy by closely examining its ideological underpinnings. The talk was followed by a question and answer session moderated by Prof. Rajaram, Head of Dept. of English. The talk was well appreciated by the participants and they have put ina request to conduct more such talks on the National Education Policy.

International Webinar Series on Sustainable Development Goals - 2030

Episode 1 – 'Synergising Sustainable Goals: Envisioning The Future We Want' The first episode of the International Webinar Series on Sustainable Development Goals - 2030 (IWSSDGs-2030) titled 'Synergising Sustainable Goals: Envisioning the Future We Want.' was held virtually on 29th August at 4 pm on the MS Teams platform. The series is organized in collaboration with United Nations Global Compact Network (UN GCN) India, MAHSA University, SACHH Foundation and Women in Tech Maldives. The flagship event received over 950 registrations from across the globe. The webinar witnessed participants from Malaysia, UAE,

Indonesia, Mauritius, Uzbekistan, Japan, Maldives, Turkey, Nigeria, Tanzanian, Nepal, Bhutan, Mexico, South Africa, Italy, Mali, Nepal, USA, Philippines, Belgium, and India. The episode focused on the importance of the SDGs - 2030 proposed by the UN and adopted by all member nations.

Dr. Arun Jacob, officer at UN Resident Coordination Office delivered the Keynote address.

The keynote address was followed by a panel discussion, moderated by CA Sandhya P Nagar. The three panellists belonged to diverse areas pertaining to SDGs-2030 and hence offered a multi-dimensional perspective to the SDGs. Dr. Abhijit Sharma, the Director of the Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship (Guwahati) shared his views on fostering entrepreneurship to achieve localisation of SDGs focusing on North-East India and practicalities of Atmanirbhar Bharat schemes. The second panellist, Mr. Abhimanyu Manimaran, Strategic Advisor at UNGC Norway provided insights on the Economic Donut and integrating the circular systems approach with the future we want to envision. The final panellist, Mr. Sankalp Mohan Sharma, youth activist and founder of Sachh Foundation spoke about the involvement and mobilisation of youth in realising the SDGs.

Episode 2: Can We Achieve The SDGs Without Human Rights?

The second episode of the International Webinar Series on Sustainable Development Goals (IWSSDGs- 2030) was held online on 17th October, 2020. The episode titled Can we achieve the SDGs without Human Rights? featured Mr. Salil Shetty, Fellow, Harvard University, Human Rights

Activist, Former Director, United Nations Millennium Campaign in conversation with Ms. Geetha Menon, co-founder of Stree Jagruti Samiti. Both the guest speakers, experts in their own fields, provided valuable insights on the relevance of Human Rights in achieving the SDGs. The speakers emphasized on the fact that civil, political and socio-economic rights are indisputably inter-related. The discussion concluded with a Q&A session which offered engaging perspectives on the ground realities concerning human rights and pressing need for immediate action. The webinar received an overwhelming response of 900 plus registrations out of which 512 attended from India, Tibet, Bangladesh, Malaysia, Mexico, Tanzania, Geneva, Nigeria, Nepal, Indonesia, South Africa, USA, Nigeria, Mali, Philippines, United Arab Emirates and Oman.

Episode 3: Child Rights In The Conflict Zones Of Asia

The third episode of the International Webinar Series on Sustainable Development Goals was conducted on 23rd January, 2021. The episode was titled "Child Rights in the Conflict Zones of Asia" and it discussed the plight of children in Asia with special focus on India and Afghanistan. The webinar received an overwhelming response of 450 plus registrations out of which 272 attended from India, Tibet, Bangladesh, Malaysia, Mexico, Tanzania, Geneva, Nigeria, Nepal, Indonesia, South Africa, USA, Nigeria, Mali, Philippines, United Arab Emirates and Oman.

The panelists for the day were Prof. Asha Bajpai, Dean and Professor of law at TISS, Mumbai and a visiting faculty at the Institute of Law, Nirma University, Mr. Sonykutty George, a Child Protection Specialist in the Hyderabad field office of UNICEF, and Mr. Mohammad Salim, the International Coordinator at World Courts of Women and co-founder of the Vimochana Forum for Human Rights. Mr. Gladson J S, the outreach coordinator of SJCC moderated the event.

Annual Republic Day Lecture 2020 - 2021

The Department of English conducted the third edition of the Annual Republic Day Lecture Series on the 18th of January, 2021 on Monday at 5.30 p.m. as a hybrid event both on campus and via live stream on the college'sofficial Youtube channel. The event went on for 1 hour 30 minutes. The speaker was the renowned thinker and cultural critic Prof. G.

N. Devy. Thetitle of the talk was "The Third Decade: New Horizons of Expectations". Prof. Devy placed his talk in the context of understanding the foundation of a republic. He stated that a desire for a transformed world is the idea of republic. He, as promised in the title, offered an analysis of the prevailing world situation in relation to environment, politics, frontiers of knowledge and the human capacity for action. Apart from SJCC students, there were anumber of participants from different universities across Bangalore and India. The relevance of the talk in the present political context was noted in the post-talk discussions. The implications of re-imagining AI through reframing existing languages were also discussed with much fervor

Faculty Development Programmes (FDP) / Workshops Organized

1. Financial Reporting: Preparation and Presentation of Statements

On the 3rd of August 2020, Mr. Milind Date was invited to deliver a talk on 'Financial Reporting: Preparation and Presentation of Statements'. This session enabled the speaker to guide the faculty members in understanding the implications of IndAS and IFRS, over the preparation and presentation of financial statements.

2. An Overview of Financial Accounting

On the 5th of August 2020, CA Jayakumar conducted a faculty empowerment programme on 'An Overview of Financial Accounting', to provide the teachers with a deeper understanding of how the subject can be approached in the class.

3. EBSCO BSE and New MobileApp Awareness

A webinar on 'Training and demonstration of EBSCO database' was organized by the SJCC Research Centre, in association with Library and Information Centre of SJCC on September 12th, 2020. Mr. Sreenivas, the Training manager from EBSCO was the resource person. The objective of the programme was to familiarize the scholars with various databases of EBSCO and easy ways to explore them for the purpose of research.

4. Transforming Learning using Case Study as a pedagogical tool

Dr. Soney Mathew and Dr. Augustin Amaladas conducted a session on the 8th of August, 2020, on

the topic 'Transforming Learning using Case Study as a pedagogical tool'. This session helped the teachers understand the use of case study as a pedagogical tool, the various types of case studies that are used in Commerce and Management and the method of case analysis and evaluation techniques employed during case solutions.

5. E-content development and Navigation for online courses

A session on 'E-content development and Navigation for online courses' was conducted by Dr. Raja Jebasingh. This session was conducted to guide the staff members in the collaborations with the UGC and MHRD, to contribute for the e-content development on SWAYAM portal.

6. Self-Care: Empower yourself to reach out

Dr. Rekha Ahuja conducted a session on the 7th of December 2020, on 'Self-Care: Empower yourself toreach out'. The speaker started the session by sheddinglighton how it is important to prioritize self-care today. She emphasized on the topics that are overlooked in the mainstream education viz., theteachingfraternity. She motivated the faculty members to have a healthy balance in their lives that also accommodates self-care which enables them to effectively reach out to the students in need, as well. In a following session on 12th December, titled 'Walk the Talk: Accompanying Students with Awarenessand Empathy', Dr. Ahuja gave great insight into how class mentoring. She explained how situations can be handled effectively by providing detailed references to certain case studies that showcased difficult scenarios handled effectivelyby a trained faculty, through empathy.

7. Overview of Excel

On the 7th of December 2020, Dr. Sridhar. L. S. conducted a session on the 'Overview of Excel'. Through this session, he gave a practical demonstration on certain functions of Excel that can be used for the effective functioning of the classroom environment. He also conducted practical sessions that helped the staff embers engage in Excel usage.

8. Dimensions of Interdisciplinary Pedagogy- a personal reflection

Dr. Rajaram conducted a session for all the staff members on the 'Dimensions of Interdisciplinary Pedagogy- a personal reflection' on the 9th of December, 2020. Through the session, he dissected the interdisciplinary approach in education by talking about the collaboration, combination and convergence. He pushed the attendees to be comfortable beyond the blurred boundaries. He spurred them 'to be interested to be interesting'. He also elaborated on the limitations of interdisciplinary pedagogy which shows that deep study may not be possible in this approach.

9. Revisiting Gandhi and Ambedkar today

On the 17th of December, 2020, Dr. Rajaram held another faculty empowerment programme on 'Revisiting Gandhi and Ambedkar today'. Through the session, the teachers gained insight into the Gandhian philosophy of Aparigraha, Aaswadha and Ahimsa. They also learned of how Ambedkar's view was like that of a social physician, who diagnosed the Hindu psyche as one in the ascending order of reverence and descending order of contempt. Dr. Rajaram also pointed out how Ambedkar had analyzed

that Indian men are gynophobic, because of which they either divinize or demonize women. He also spoke about the dangers of the conspiracy of silence and cooption. He concluded the session by stressing on the importance of self-reflection in religions and religious groups.

10. Ethics and Ethical issues

On the 9th of December, Fr. Kurian Kachapilly conducted a faculty empowerment programme on 'Ethics and Ethical issues' for the members of the staff. In the session, he explored the possibilities of ethics being founded in feelings, religious beliefs, laws and society. Through further discussions, it was realized that standards, rights and virtues were the foundational framework of ethics. He also elaborated on the common goals of ethics as beneficence, non-maleficence and, respect for freedom and justice.

Fr. Kurian Kachapilly also conducted a session on the 10th of December, 2020, on the same topic where he spoke of the traditional ethical theories viz., utilitarianism, universalism and rights. He also gave a purview on the emergent theories, categorical imperative, universalism by Immanuel Kant and his maxim viz., Consistency, Human Dignity and Universality. He gave a brief purview onmoral and legal entitlements.

In his final session on the 11th of December, 2020, Fr. Kurian gave insight into virtue ethics, theories of justice and the different degrees of freedom. He also spoke at length on the western perspective theories and Taoism. He emphasized on how educational quotient is a holistic approach of looking at things rather than a being strictly confined to an intellectual, emotional or spiritual context.

11. Outcome-based Education

Dr. Himachalapathy held an Outcome-based Education session on the 9th of December 2020, where he outlined the importance of OBE. He alsoprovided insights into the renewed framework of Bloom's Taxonomy. In a following session held by him on the 10th of December, 2020, Dr. Himachalapathy conducted a practical session on how to to identify the COs and POs with their relevant T levels and K levels. In his final session on 11th December, 2020, Dr. Himachalapathy elaborated on how to create rubrics for evaluation and how itcan be practically applied in our class framework.

12. The Need to Engage With The Community

A session on 'The need to engage with the community' was conducted by Mr. Gurumoorthy and Dr. Shirdi Prasad Tekur on the 14th of December, 2020. The session started with activities related to Sustainable Development Goals and the staff members were divided into groups to address issues related to Food, Women, Health and Environment. Discussions on the first level i.e., preventing things from going wrong, second level i.e., early diagnosis of the problem, and the third level i.e., limiting or arresting the problem, were conducted. Eachgroup analyzed the issues on the basis of facts, circumstances and the backgrounds of people involved.

13. Discernment, Magis and AMDG

On the 15th of December, 2020, Fr. Jossie D'Mello conducted a session on 'Discernment, Magis and AMDG' for the staff members of SJCC. In this session, Fr. talked about the Jesuit principles of 'Magis' and 'Cura Personalis'. He spoke of the importance of leading by example and stressed on the noble deed of doing things for the greater glory of God. He also narrated the experiences of St. Ignatius- the founding father of the Society of Jesus, the uniqueness of Jesuit education and how discernment is the central theme of the Jesuit worldview. He elaborated on how these principles must influence the process of decision-making in our daily lives and the importance of reviewing our actions on a daily basis.

14. The role of teachers in creating socially responsible student leaders

On the 16th of December, 2020, Prof. Y. J. Rajendra conducted a session on 'The role of teachers in creating socially responsible student leaders'. Through this session, he conducted an activity to explore issues from cultural, social, economic and political perspectives. He addressed the issues related to women and Dalits in the country, through presentations from teachers themselves exploring these topics.

15. Higher Education in the contemporary socio-economic and political context

Mr. Shiva Sundar conducted a session for the faculty members on the topic 'Higher Education in the contemporary socio-economic and political context' on the 16th of December, 2020. He explained to the attendees, in detail, about the neoliberal state be ing an imminent and anger for the Indian society and the possible ways to address it. The guest also spoke of the importance of creating awareness among students and urged the faculty to encourage students to engage in dialogue. He also explained how India is among the countries under Genocidal watch and pushed the members to change the country for the better, collectively.

16. Jesuit Heritage

On the 17th of December 2020, Fr. Olvin Veigus SJ conducted a session on 'Jesuit

Heritage'. Fr explained the need to imbibe Ignatian spiritualityin our daily lives and encouraged us to inculcate the skill of imagery. He discussed at length about the introduction of Jesuit philosophy in education, and thedesire to do more through Magis. He stressed on the importance of living a contemplative

life that follows the principle of Ratio Studiorum (Rational of Studying) imbibed in Jesuit educational institutions across the globe. He also gave insights into the life of Jesuits in a glance, thus inspiring teachers to fulfill their duties towards the student community.

17. Artificial Intelligence in Business Ecosystem

In collaboration with the Center for Learning, Development and Transformation of Mount Carmel College (Autonomous), St. Joseph's College of Commerce conducted six online sessions on 'Artificial Intelligence in Business Ecosystem' from the 8th to the 30th of January, 2021. This faculty development programme was conducted taking into consideration the digitalization of business organizations and the economy, on the whole. To comprehend the role of Al in all the various areas of operations in business, like HR, Marketing, Accounting, Finance and

Entrepreneurship, experts were invited to deliver lectures on the topics 'How AI is shaping the world of Entrepreneurship', 'AI: The game-changer for future', 'Recent trends in AI-driven marketing', 'The growing impact of AI in financial services', 'Transformative impact of AI in Banking industry' and 'Insights into AI enabled systems for Accounting and Finance. Each session was two-hours long and provided great insight for the attendees to understand the changes in the world of business, thus enabling them to adopt new strategies in teaching these subjects.

Train the trainer program

Faculty members handling Professional Programmes undergo 'Train the Trainer' programmes on a regular basis. This programme enables the teaching staff to be up-to- date with the changes in the syllabus of the professional programs. These sessions are handled by external experts from the industry, thereby also bridging the gap between theory and practice. Changes in the syllabus, pedagogy, examination tips and paper evaluation methodology are commonly discussed topics.
