- 7 to 8 students are from Bangalore University and many outstation and other institutions have applied for the PG program
- 31 in M.Com, 22 in MIB, and 22 in MFA
- According to Principal Admission completion is 14 November. According to HOD admissions were comparatively low.
- Fourth round of admission is 10 August. After many rounds of discussion
- Many are of the opinion to keep start of class of first year 16 August.
- Decided to start the college for first year as only the difference is ten days.
- Regarding the absentees, to take action on first year students and also the second year what action to be taken against the students.
- To have process of change in programme to follow the same policy which we were following in the yester years to be followed.
