



4.	The College is offering three P.G Courses viz., M.Com. M.Com. (FA) and M.Com. (IB) are being offered. The total faculty strength is 118 of whom 21 are on contract basis and 41 members have Ph.D. degree. The Research Centre has 5 recognised guides, 10 members are proposed for recognition as Research Guideship. The College has 13 Research Scholars allotted by Bangalore University.
5.	The college has organized good number of Conferences, Seminars. Workshops etc. The faculty members are actively engaged in research and publications.
6.	The Class Rooms are ICT enabled and the college has supporting softwares, LAN, WIFI, Firewall etc with sufficient bandwidth.
7.	The Library has impressive collection of books and Journals. 17 International and 6 Indian Journals for PG Course and 11 International and 61 Indian Journals for UG course are subscribed. Exclusive place is provided for Research Scholars with 25 systems. The software to check plagiarism is also in place. The required E-resources are also subscribed.
8.	The faculty members are encouraged to undertake Research Projects by the management. In addition to the financial assistance of the Government Agencies the Management is also providing financial assistance, sabbatical leave, free access for database etc.
9.	The college is well equipped with adequate facilities for conducting Research Programmes leading to Ph.D. degree.

Conditions:


1.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) The College /Research Centre should actively collaborate with the University in organizing the Conferences, Seminars, Webinars/Special Lectures and other research activities. b) The College /Research Centre should share the resources, such as Library, Laboratories; expertise and any other facilities in the best interest of both the University and College/Research Centre. c) The College /Research Centre should take all such necessary measures to strengthen the academic and research ties.
2.	The eligible faculty should apply for recognition as guides in the prescribed format along with supporting documents relating to academic qualifications, copy of the regular appointment with designation, scale of pay, years of teaching experience three publications after the award of Ph.D. Degree.

3.	The College has to make provision for instituting research fellowships or teaching/research associateship for the eligible research scholars.
4.	The Management of the College shall undertake to retain the recognized guides during the course of research scholars.
5.	The proposed guides should also undertake to continue to work in the college till the completion of the term of research in the event of recognition and allotment of scholars.
6.	The faculty should undertake research projects relevant and required for the present socio-economic conditions.




